

## Case Study

### Site Description – Heavy Crude Oil

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**Site Location:** Yellow Sea, Dalian, China



**Site Description:** China's largest oil spill happened after two pipelines transferring crude oil exploded in July 2010, spilling oil into the Bohai Gulf. An estimated 11,000 barrels (1,500 tons) of crude leaked into the ocean creating an oil slick that expanded over 100 square kilometers.

Two of our oil degrading products, The Oppenheimer Formula and BioZorb were used.

**Contaminant:** Heavy Crude Oil.

**Recommended Treatment Method :** The products were broadcast dry over the affected areas.

**Goal:** To reduce the amount of oil sludge that coated the rocky shoreline.
